

TRAINING CAMP INFORMATION KIT

20 years before the official opening of the ski area in 1966, Mont-Sainte-Anne was the host, in February 1947, of the Alpine Skiing Canadian Championships. This event was the first in a long list of major competitions.

Mont-Sainte-Anne continues to participate in the development of the sport and the racers by hosting again this year several competitions and by offering training camps on the best pre-season race training conditions.

RESERVATION & LANE ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION

Reservation *:

- Minimum of 48 hours ahead by phone, e-mail or fax including dates requested, type of training, AM session / PM session, and total number in group (athletes and coaches).

* **Please indicate your needs clearly on the registration form, so we can better serve you.**

Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 25% deposit on the training lanes fees.

- The balance is due upon arrival.
- We will book space on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **All athletes or the coach representing the athletes will be asked to sign a release of liability form before the beginning of their camp.**

Cancellation policy:

- Mont-Sainte-Anne Ski Resort reserves the privileges of cancellation up to 5 days before first booked day. Full refund of deposit will be issued.
- A full refund of the deposit less 10% administration fees will be issued for any cancellation received more than 5 days before the first booked day of training.
- **No refund for cancellation received less than 3 days before the first booked day of training**

PLEASE NOTE :

The captain's meeting each day is mandatory for all team captains when requested by the Mountain Safety Supervisor. Due to the demands for certain training lanes, the following policy will be enforced for the 2011-2012 season:

- If two or more teams are requesting the same lanes for the same days, a draw will be done at the captain's meeting to establish a rotation on that lane, there is a 3-day maximum per lane for each team. Otherwise, lanes will be assigned by Mont-Sainte-Anne and negotiated at the captain's meeting according to skiing calibre, training lane availability and snow conditions in order to keep the skiing environment as safe as possible.
- Small teams with less than 10 participants must train with other teams. Mont-Sainte-Anne reserves the right to regroup teams if lane shortages occur.
- To keep the skiing environment as safe as possible the calibre of the teams is also a criteria for trail assignment.
- **All courses must be side slipped at the end of the morning training sessions.** All courses must be vacated at the prearranged time or a penalty may be charged.
- During the premium time, Mont-Sainte-Anne guarantees just one session per day, per team.
- All participants must obey the Skier's Responsibility Code and Mont-Sainte-Anne Ski Resort's policies.
 - Safety of all participants is constantly the most important issue.
